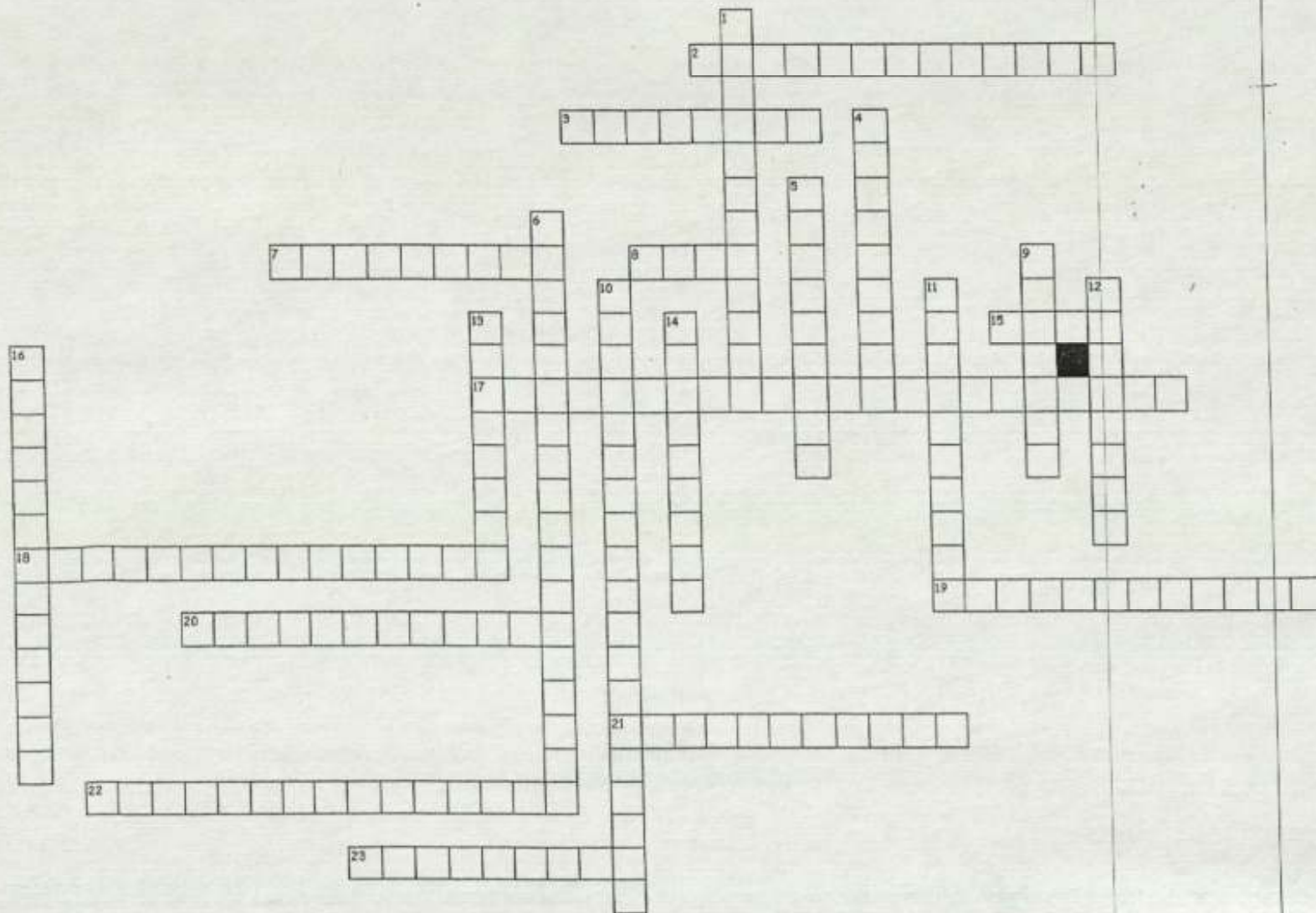

- 2. an economic and political union of 27 independent member states which are located primarily in Europe.
- 3. penalties imposed by a country or group of countries on another country or group of countries.

- 8. group of 12 nations that pursues ways and means of ensuring the stabilization of prices in international oil markets.
- 15. military alliance between 26 countries (EX. UK, France, US, Germany) where its member countries agree to mutual defense in response to an attack by any external party.
- 17. a political system in which the legislature (parliament) selects the government - a prime minister, premier, or chancellor along with the cabinet ministers.
- 18. a particular form of government adopted by some Muslim states; in theory, a theocracy, it remains a republic, but its laws are required to be compatible with the laws of Islam.
- 19. a government that seeks to subordinate the individual by controlling all political and economic matters, the attitudes, values, and beliefs of its population.
